GLAAACC COLLEGE PREP COURSE

COLLEGE PREP

The GLAAACC Education Fund & Foundation hosts a college prep course which provides youth from disadvantaged backgrounds with the academic support, financial assistance, and leadership training to become college graduates. This course is unique in that it leverages board members from companies such as Southern California Edison, SoCal Gas, Microsoft, and JP Morgan Chase, to help students who have demonstrated strong academic potential and a commitment to success, but who have knowledge or opportunity gaps in reaching their potential.

Our course prepares students for the 21st century by fostering skills in critical thinking, communication, collaboration, and creativity. We also emphasize proficiency with technology, as its effective use is a requisite skill in higher education and the workplace. The course has a strong mentoring component that focuses not only on mechanics of completing scholarship applications, but also goal setting, exploring careers, and succeeding once enrolled in college. Through engagement in our program students develop the skills, habits, attitudes, and expertise they need to become accomplished adults.



GLAAACC STUDENT COURSES

DIGITAL SKILLING

The Digital Skills and training course helps to develop the digital and information literacy, desktop and IT productivity skills of students to help them work, research and study more effectively and to support continuing professional development.

FINANCIAL LITERACY

Financial literacy is important because it allows a student to understand and maximize whatever level of income they earn. The course will teach students to search and assess college and career opportunities, identify and prioritize their personal money management goals, develop personal spending and savings plans, comprehend the impact of time on the value of money, understand the cost of using credit, and protect assets.

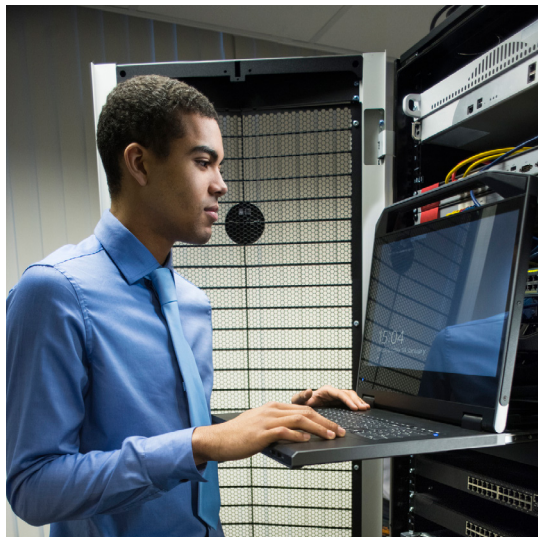


GLAAACC INTERNSHIPS & MENTORSHIPS

GLAAACC Ed Fund Internship Program is a program designed to give college students an opportunity to experience the workplace prior to graduation and enhance their education while working with GLAAACC partner companies. Individual goals are created to empower youth, and to master life skills that enhance his/her future success in college and job readiness.



ED FUND ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP RECEPTION

For two decades GLAAACC Education Fund and Foundation has helped students achieve the dream of college. This program reflects the vision of the GLAAACC Chairman Gene hale and his generosity and leadership in Los Angeles. As GLAAACC Education Fund and Foundation looks ahead to its next century, we celebrate the important continuity this program brings to our community and culture, as well as our shared values of leadership, responsibility and service.

One of the Foundation's signature events is its Annual Scholarship Awards Reception which now awards \$6,000 scholarships to deserving inner-city high school seniors from Crenshaw, George Washington Preparatory and Susan Miller Dorsey high schools. The Foundation has had the honor of featuring prominent keynote speakers such as basketball legend & six-time NBA MVP Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, former Los Angeles city Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa and LAUSD Superintendent Dr. John E. The Foundation has awarded over \$600,000 in scholarships to students from at risk communities who are graduating with the skills, passion, and leadership experiences to help their home communities.
