## Business Evolution Program (BEP)

The BEP Program offers a broad scope of assistance to small businesses that are owned and controlled at least 51% by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals. It's an exclusive opportunity for low to moderate and small business owners to accelerate their potential by infusing new knowledge and to prepare for new challenges ahead. With the help of our industry professionals, the program allows small businesses to maximize their learning journey.

20 GLAAACC members will participate in this year's program, all of which have been in business for 3-5 years. Our research indicates that at this point in the business life-cycle, this is a critical time to strengthen business finance, marketing, human resources, and product development.

The biggest challenge for entrepreneurs in this stage is dividing time between a whole new range of demands requiring their attention— managing increasing levels of revenue, attending to customers, dealing with the competition, and accommodating an expanding workforce.

#### **Project Details:**

This is a 12-month program, broken down into 12 Modules, integrating instruction from industry professionals and GLAAACC Board of Directors. Module subjects include: contracting, procurement, supplier diversity, lending, and professional business services, intensive technical assistance, technology, access to capital, and leader-led classroom training.



At the completion of the program, participants will acquire more than just management skills, small businesses will possess a richer understanding of the business foundation, relevant strategies for growth, and new ways to apply for contracts to propel the small business to the next level of success.

### **Women in the C-Suite**

Women in the C-Suite is a program designed to create a safe space and help build self-confidence and opportunities among women business owners. This program focuses on black women's leadership and subject matter experts discussing the challenges, obstacles, and successes of what it takes to occupy the elusive corner C-Suite.



This is an opportunity for leading women business owners in a panel setting in various industries to share successful experiences and best practices on starting and running a business in today's world, while learning from others.

There will be strategic initiatives for procurement opportunities with various companies. Overall, women entrepreneurs can network and learn from other entrepreneurs.



Pre recorded video tutorials will be produced quarterly for website download on various small business fundamental subjects:


- How To Access Capital and other financial products


